### **Signal Reconstruction at 5<sup>th</sup> and South Streets, October 19 - November 16**

**LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – October 20, 2020** – The City of Lafayette is installing a new traffic signal at the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> and South Streets in downtown Lafayette from October 19 through November 16, 2020. This is not a road closure, but a notification to the public that the signal will be removed for a period of time during construction. While the old signal is removed, the intersection will become a two-way stop. There will be two stop signs, northbound 5<sup>th</sup> Street and southbound 5<sup>th</sup> Street, with additional signage, 'Cross Traffic Does Not Stop' posted. At times as the new poles and mast arms are being installed, traffic will be limited to a single lane through the intersection. Please be cautious of the lane restriction and street crews in this area.
